- 1. Spots are limited and space sizes are 65 ft x 19 ft widths and boundaries are strictly enforced.
- 2. If your vehicles are too wide or long for these spots you will be required to purchase multiple spots (when available).
- 3. You will be required to park in your reserved spot within your boundaries. If you are outside the boundaries you have paid for; you will be required to move or pay for additional spots (when available).
- 4. You are paying a convenience fee of reserving your spots from the first day they are available. First come, first serve. For instance, if you show up on Sunday morning to race, your spot is available from the day you started reserving. No need to rush to get to the track for a prime spot, you can call and reserve.

From 15 South (traveling North to South) - Interstate 15 to Joshua St Exit, turn right onto Joshua Street, proceed to intersection of Joshua and Route 395, continue to stop sign, turn right onto Caliente to stop sign, turn left onto Muscatel and then immediate right turn continuing on Caliente to stop sign, turn right onto Aspen, track entrance is ahead on left.

From 15 North (traveling South to North) - Interstate 15 to Route 395 Exit, proceed to intersection of Joshua and Route 395, turn left onto Joshua continue to stop sign, turn right onto Caliente to stop sign, turn left onto Muscatel and then immediate right turn continuing on Caliente to stop sign, turn right onto Aspen, track entrance is ahead on left.

Wristbands: You are required to put on your wristband when purchased at the CEMX front gates. You must wear your wristband at all times. If you leave CEMX facility, you must have your wristband on your wrist in order to re-enter. If you do not have your wristband when returning or entering CEMX facility, you will be required to purchase a wristband. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Food Vendors: Food vendors will be available on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. See the local restaurant information under local services. Water, Energy Drinks and snacks are available at the front gate of the facility.

Restrooms: Restrooms are available throughout the CEMX facility. If the restrooms need service, please advise a parking attendant or other track official.

Spectator Areas: Spectator Areas are clearly marked; the racetrack is OFF LIMITS AT ALL TIMES to spectators. Spectators are not permitted to enter the racetrack for any purpose. Parents, you are responsible for your own children at all times. Please do not take banners off the track, violators will be prosecuted.

Trash Cans: Please use CEMX trash receptacles. If you need trash bags, you can get them from the front gate.

Search Policy: All vehicles are subject to search at any time. If any fireworks, glass containers, or other prohibited items are found, you may remove them from the property yourself, or we will dispose of them for you. We are not responsible for the safe return of any contraband removed.

Prohibited Items: No fireworks, weapons, beer kegs, glass containers, scaffolding or ladders.

Camp Fires: No open fires (fire pits required), no large bond fires, no burning of pallets, furniture or garbage.









Dogs: All dogs must be leashed while at CEMX facility. The owner of any dog is liable for the damages suffered by any person who is bitten by the dog while in a public place or lawfully in a private place, including the property of the owner of the dog, regardless of the former viciousness of the dog or the owner's knowledge of such viciousness.

PA and FM Radio: Keep your radio tuned to FM 92.1 for up to date announcements even though we utilize the public address system, the FM broadcast is the best way to stay informed.

Pit Vehicles: Pit vehicles (mopeds, scooters, pit bikes, golf carts, mules, ATVs, UTVs) may be used. Operators must be 16 years or older in order to operate a pit vehicle and must sign the liability release. **Helmets must be worn for ALL pit vehicles.** Only racers and campers are eligible to use Pit Vehicles. Day Spectators are not eligible to use pit vehicles. Proof of age may be requested by track staff, unauthorized pit vehicles may subject related racer to penalty, or even disqualification.

Speed Limit: The speed limit throughout the pits, entrances, roadways to and from tracks is 5 MPH. Excessive speed will not be tolerated and may subject related racer to penalty, or even disqualification.

Regional Qualifier Advancement

General Information

We will accept alternates for any class not pre-entered to 41 riders. If a class pre-enters with over 41 riders, we will accept alternates to 82 riders. We will not accept alternates to make any class over 41 riders that does not come already pre-registered over that number.

All alternates must attend rider registration and register in each class in which the rider is an alternate.

Alternates who did not pre-enter may post-enter at the event by completing the post-entry form and paying the applicable MX Sports fee(s) and entry fee(s).

Alternates will be placed based upon a power-ranking calculated by the number of riders at the qualifier level, i.e., alternates from qualifiers with the most riders will be given priority placement. In other words, a withdrawn rider will not necessarily be replaced by an alternate from the same qualifier as the withdrawn rider.

Once a class is full, no further Alternates can be placed unless a seeded rider withdraws from the program prior to the start of the first moto of that class. This means that even if a gate is empty on the starting line of the first moto, we still cannot place an Alternate in that position. Once a rider earns a gate position, it cannot be given to an Alternate without the rider's consent, even if the rider fails to race the first moto. A rider may in fact miss the first moto but race the 2nd and 3rd motos. After the first moto of a class is run, no Alternates can be placed in that class.

Registration Procedures Continued

Riders can enter a total of 4 classes at the Regional. However, a rider is limited to only 2 classes at the National. Thus, if a rider qualifies in more than 2 classes, he will have to declare which 2 classes he will compete in at the National.

All riders, including minors, MUST check in at registration area. You will need your transponder number your bike frame number.

At registration the rider and/or rider parents or guardian shall:

Get Transponder (if not supplying your own).

Register for the appropriate classes.

Register for optional Friday practice.

Pay all practice and race entry fees.

Sign all entry, insurance and liability release forms.

Obtain practice stickers.

If a rider is in 2 classes and the practice sessions for those classes are run together, or the rider is in back-toback practice sessions, he may request to practice with a different group for his second class. Otherwise, riders may not practice with classes in which they are not qualified.
